JARAFA 's mission is to

create accessible self-paced training resources for folks across the progressive ecosystem, including those who've never engaged before.





- We were inspired by the term 'Jargon Giraffe'!
- There's a lot of jargon in the progressive world, with Jirafa we aim to demystify those words through course content that's fun and easily accessible in a variety of ways and languages.
- In our work experiences we noticed a glaring lack of training materials in multiple languages.





- With Jirafa we plan to bridge the accessibility gap, and not just via translation, but by addressing various tech levels, learning styles and experiences as well.
 - We really want to meet folks where they are, even if this is their first time touching a computer or volunteering!
 - We recognize not everyone learns the same way, so all our curriculums are built with a variety of learning styles in mind, and courses are meant to be repeated as needed because learning is lifelong!





- We also noticed a lack of quality control in what training materials
 are provided by vendors. They vary widely tool to tool and are often
 intended for admins only, so not accessible for any volunteers who
 may be working with the front end.
- With Jirafa we plan to widen the scope of what tools have accessible training materials and who the trainings are meant for.
 - We plan diverse curriculum for our courses, that contain content and examples actually applicable to real life in the progressive ecosystem.


- To be as accessible as possible to users and for trainers, Jirafa would be designed as a mobile app, accessible on iOS and Android.
- During the last year we have taken courses on Python 3 and Django. We also utilized Figma wireframe and plan out the mobile application.



Gamification

- We know fitting in time to learn when you already have a busy day is hard so we wanted to make Jirafa fun, something to look forward to doing!
- Completing certain things, like a course or a quiz, will earn you points which you can exchange for things, plus the ability for your public username to be listed on the scoreboard!
 - Organizers like goals, so we want to take that to the next level by encouraging competition and creating FOMO around what points can be exchanged for.





Course Page

- Our course pages would include multilingual video demos for users to watch and review whenever they want.
- After watching the video, users would be asked to answer several questions before they can move on to the next section of the course.
